Main activities	<p>When various Japan-Mexico friendship memorial events were held in Mexico in 2014, we gathered a group of people from Fukushima Prefecture. These people previously volunteered and had experience working with the Japanese Ambassador Megata. We formed the Kenjinkai in order to hold events and promote Fukushima Prefecture in Mexico</p> <p>In addition, to our regular meetings twice a year (New Year's party and Year-End party), we also have a booth every year at the autumn festival sponsored by the Japan Mexico Association. At the booth we sell Namie Yakisoba, Imoni (soup) and Fukushima Prefecture produced sake to Mexican people, we also distribute each area's tourist pamphlets and promotional material. At the end of the year, I will attend the emperor's birthday celebration event to be held at the official residence of the Japanese Ambassador and hand out Akabeko (red cow) goods, etc., while carrying out educational activities.</p> <p>We also have charity events run by volunteer members, with earnings going to the local governments in our hometown. In addition to this we also hold awareness-raising programs in Mexico about Hideo Noguchi's activities in Mexico, and invite children from Fukushima prefecture to our local schools on a irregular basis. And finally we promote cultural exchange between Mexican and Japanese people.</p>
